For Visitors with Impaired Vision

For Visitors with Impaired Hearing

Hearing-assistive devices are available from the Festival staff for worship services and other events at all of the venues. Please sign them out when you arrive and return them before you move on to the next venue.

Parking

There is no public parking at any of the venues in Denver this year. There are handicap accessible spaces located at all three churches on a first come basis. There are also ample parking ramps and surface lots located near each of them. You can also use [Spot Hero](#) to help you locate and reserve a parking spot for the day prices vary according to location.

Service of Holy Eucharist

To receive Holy Communion in your aisle, please ask an usher when you arrive. Holy Communion is typically offered at the first and last services of the week.

Entry and Elevator

Entrances are on the west and north sides of the main building. The office is accessible at the Broadway entrance, from street level, going down the stairs to the Plaza and entering through the glass doors at the bottom of the stairs.

Accessible entrance is available from the north door of the main building on street level. Enter the door, go left through the main hallway, past the two sets of stairs and the elevator is on the left at the end of the hall.

Wheelchair-Accessible Spaces

All of Ebenezer is wheelchair accessible. There is designated seating for wheelchairs and those with limited mobility. Please place the reserved seating sign on the floor under your seat.

Entry and Elevator

Accessible entrances are located on the front of the church (north side). An elevator is located just inside the ground floor door. Signage will help with location.

Wheelchair-Accessible Spaces

Most of the Church is wheelchair accessible. Accessible access to the sanctuary, chapel, Fellowship Hall and second floor rooms are available via elevator. There is designated seating for wheelchairs and those with limited mobility. Please place the reserved seating sign on the floor under your seat. A wheelchair is available for emergencies.

Restrooms

A wheelchair-accessible restroom is located on the first floor straight down the hall after you exit the elevator.

Parking

Central is located at [1660 Sherman St](#) at the corner of 17th Avenue, cater-corner to the Wells Fargo skyscraper ("cash-register building") in downtown Denver. The church has [parking information](#) on their website. The complimentary garage parking only applies to Saturday/Sunday worship.

Entry and Elevator

There are ground level entrances at the front of the church (west side) which lead to an elevator. When you enter the building from these doors, please turn right and go to the end of the hall. The elevator will be on your right.

Wheelchair-Accessible Spaces

Most all of St. Paul's is wheelchair accessible via the elevator. There is designated seating for wheelchairs and those with limited mobility. Please place the reserved seating sign on the floor under your seat. A wheelchair is available for emergencies.

Restrooms

A wheelchair-accessible restroom is located in the basement adjacent to the Fellowship Hall. Signage will help with location.

Parking

On Sunday mornings, parking is allowed on 16th Avenue by the church. Also, there are metered spots throughout the neighborhood — most are free after 6pm and on weekends. The nearest pay parking lot is on the southwest corner of 16th and Grant. The cost is \$7 on evenings and weekends.
